## Will Governor O'Bannon help stop it?

But last week the O'Bannon administration cut funds for our tobacco prevention program by nearly 80%, virtually destroying its future. 20,500 Indiana kids get hooked on tobacco each year. 1 in 3 will die prematurely from it. Governor O'Bannon has the power to help prevent this tragedy by restoring funding from the tobacco settlement for our tobacco prevention program.
